

Hopkins Township Board Minutes

Regular Meeting

August 14, 2017

Meeting called to order by Modreske at 7:35 p.m.

Board members present: Alberda, Morris, Modreske

Board members absent: Wamhoff with notice and Evans with notice.

Modreske lead the meeting in Evans absence.

Motion by Morris, supported by Alberda to approve the agenda. All Ayes.

Motion by Alberda, supported by Modreske to approve the minutes of last month's meeting for the July 10th regular meeting with a correction to the minutes adding the following to the treasurers report section of the minutes: May 2017 treasures report was fixed at that time. All Ayes.

Motion by Modreske, supported by Alberda to approve the financial report. All Ayes.
