1) Planning Commission:

This commission is responsible for maintaining the written text of the future growth plan of the township. The Planning Commission also makes recommendations of ordinance and zoning amendments.

2) Board of Appeals:

This board reviews and decides requests for variances, appeals from administrative orders or enforcement actions. The board of Appeals also interprets zoning district boundaries, when the location is in doubt. This board also interprets zoning language when its meaning is unclear.

3) Board of Review:

This board has two primary tasks. One is the review of the tax roll and correct errors that were discovered after the assessment roll was approved. The second duty is to hear appeals from citizens regarding their assessments
