Motion by Evans, supported by Hills, to approve addition of the proposed additional section in Watson Township to the Hopkins Area Fire Board district. 5 ayes.

Motion by Hills, supported by Arndt, to approve the Road Commission work order to obtain gravel bids for the 2006 gravel program. 5 ayes.

Motion by Evans, supported by Arndt, to accept the \$2,200.00 bid from Joe Jablonski for the second roadside mowing. 5 ayes.

Motion by Evans, supported by Wamhoff, to approve Administrative Resolution 4-2006 adopting the 2006-2010 Hopkins Township Parks and Recreation Master Plan. 5 ayes.

Motion by Evans, supported by Arndt, to accept the Chuck It bid for two four yard dumpsters at \$100 per dump (on call) to be placed at Maplewood Cemetery and Hillards Park for 2006 season. 5 ayes.

Motion by Arndt, supported by Evans, to put the following Millage renewals on the August ballot: Major Fire Equipment Replacement renewal for 2007 through 2010; Road Millage Renewal for 2007 and 2008; and the Road Millage Rollback Renewal for 2007 and 2008. 5 ayes.

2. Max Thiel, County Commissioner, updated the Board on County happenings.
3. Board was updated on a fund raiser to purchase a new weather siren for the Village.
4. Evans updated the Board on Fire Board matters.
