

HOPKINS TOWNSHIP BOARD MINUTES  
REGULAR MEETING  
July 14, 2008

Board members present: Hills, Modreske, Evans, Wamhoff, Arndt.

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Evans at 7:30 p.m.

Pledge of allegiance was recited.

Minutes of last months meeting were read and approved. Motion by Wamhoff, supported by Modreske. All ayes.

The financial report was presented and approved. Motion by Hills, supported by Wamhoff. All ayes.

Motion by Hills, supported by Wamhoff, to approve the payment of bills presented less \$118.61 to Leaf Financial Corporation. All ayes.

Motion by Evans, supported by Wamhoff, to approve Administrative Resolution 6-2008, re-zoning from Ag to R-1 Rural Estates approximately ten acres of parcel 0310-012-022-00 as requested by Robert and Carrie VandenBrink and approved by both the Township and County Planning Commissions. Roll Call Vote: Arndt-Aye; Hills-Aye; Wamhoff-Aye; Modreske-Aye; Evans-Aye.

Motion by Evans, supported by Hills, to approve the Smith bid of \$37,269 for 5,050 yards of gravel and to give the Clerk and Treasurer authority to pay the bill when it arrives if the amount is within 10% of the bid amount. All ayes.

Motion by Evans, supported by Hills, to approve the bid amount of \$229,858.60 for resurfacing 2.10 miles on 22<sup>nd</sup> Street and to give the Clerk and Treasurer authority to pay the bill when it arrives if the amount is within 10% of the bid amount. All ayes.

1. Evans reported that Bob Gruscinski, previous cemetery sexton, had passed away.
2. Evans informed the Board that we would be using a different computer maintenance company.
3. Evans reported that paperwork had been filed with the Veterans Administration for headstones for five soldiers with no stones.
