REGULAR MEETING
May 9, 2005

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Evans at 7:31 p.m.

Pledge of allegiance was recited.

Minutes of last months meeting were read and approved. Motion by Wamhoff, supported by Modreske. All ayes.

The financial report was presented and approved. Motion by Hills, supported by Wamhoff. All ayes.

Motion by Modreske, supported by Hills, to approve the payment of bills presented. All ayes.

Motion by Wamhoff, supported by Hills to approve Ordinance Number 2005-1, to provide for regulation of lake/riparian access and camping on vacant or residential lots. Roll call vote: Arndt-Aye; Modreske-Aye; Hills-Aye; Wamhoff-Aye; and Evans-Aye.

Motion by Evans, supported by Arndt to approve a county work order for approximately 4,500 cu. yards of gravel for the 2005 gravel program. All ayes.

Motion by Evans, supported by Arndt to add Class I Special use fee of \$25.00 to the Township fee schedule. All ayes.

Motion by Evans, supported by Arndt to have Hills write a letter to the County Commission informing them that the Hopkins Township Board is not in support of the current County ballot language or the type of jail facility proposed. All Ayes.

1. Discussed Memorial Day Services being planned for Monday, May 30th, 10:00 a.m. at Maplewood.
2. Discussed the need for grading and graveling roads at Maplewood.
3. Discussed proposed Fire Department medical first responders program. Evans reported that Bob Hess, WAEMS, would be attending the fire board meeting on July 14th at 7:30 p.m.
4. Discussed repairing accuvote machine.
5. Max Thiel, County Commissioner, was in attendance to update the Board on County events.
6. Arndt will activate dumpster service at the park and cemetery.
